The Atrium Art Gallery

The Gallery delivers a diverse programme of exhibitions, promoting work of national reputation and also recognises emerging local talent. The gallery is open to all from 9.00am - 6.00pm, Monday – Saturday.

Atrium Balcony

The Balcony is a great space for students, staff and the local community to relax or meet with friends/colleagues. It is used for workshops, drawing, creative thinking or quiet contemplation. Magazines, leaflets and flyers are available alongside art installations and displays.

BU Art Loan

Each year the BU Art Loan strives to bring new and exciting exhibitions to the University, which can be seen throughout Talbot Campus. This year we are proud to present Phase II of our collaboration with the Elisabeth Frink Estate.

In 2011/12 the public areas of Poole House and external grounds, Thomas Hardy Suite, Kimmeridge House and the Atrium Art Gallery will showcase work by the late Dame Elisabeth Frink and selected works from nationally and regionally recognised artists which demonstrate a range of creative processes and techniques.

Music at BU

Whether you are a singer or instrumentalist; whether you prefer classical or popular styles; whether you like to listen or participate, we have outstanding musical opportunities to offer you throughout your time at BU.

BU clubs & societies

BU Music offers students, staff and members of the local community the opportunity to participate in a wide variety of ensembles. All clubs & societies meet during term time at The Student Hall Talbot House; the majority do not require auditions with yearly memberships free for BU students.

BU Orchestra

The orchestra present three concerts each year in association with the Bournemouth Youth Orchestra, performing a broad repertoire. Rehearsals on Tuesday evenings 7.15pm – 9pm. To join you will need to have reached a standard equivalent to grade 5. Membership fees: free for BU students | BU staff £25 | External fee £55

BU Choir

The choir will present four major concerts this year, to include Haydn's 'Creation', Handel's 'Messiah', Mozart's 'Vespers'. Rehearsals on Tuesday evenings 5.45pm – 7.15pm. Membership fees: free for BU students | BU staff £30 | External fee £50

BU Big Band

The band welcomes all wind and brass players along with singers and keyboard players. Rehearsals on Wednesday evenings 7.30pm – 9.30pm. Membership fees: free for BU students | BU staff £40 | External fee £80

BU Chamber Choir

The chamber choir is a student choir that focuses on advanced chamber and liturgical music. Rehearsals on Tuesdays from 4.45pm – 5.45pm. To join you will need to audition for membership. There is no membership fee.



BU Contemporary Choir

New for 2012 the contemporary choir will perform a range of contemporary music from soulful classics through to musical theatre favourites. Rehearsals are Wednesday evenings 6pm – 7.15pm. Membership fees: free for BU students | BU staff £25 | External fee £50

BU Chamber Music Groups

BU Music encourages students and staff to form chamber music groups. Our string quartets and wind ensembles give regular recitals throughout the academic year.

Popular music

The music department has three piano practice rooms and two drum/band rehearsal rooms equipped with full drum kits and amplifiers. A variety of bands rehearse regularly and are always looking for new members. Search for 'BU Find a Band Mate' on facebook and join the discussion.

Individual tuition

BU Music offers individual tuition in all instruments and voice to students, staff and members of the local community. We are unable to offer tuition to students under 16 years of age. Our team of highly experienced and well-qualified teachers includes musicians from the Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra and tuition is available at all levels. Preparation for ABRSM / Trinity Guildhall grade exams and diplomas is available.

However, we equally appreciate that you might wish to learn for pleasure without the stress of formal assessment. Preparation for ABRSM theory exams at grade 5, 6, 7 and 8 is also available. Lessons last either 30 minutes or one hour and can be booked in blocks of five. We offer an initial lesson on a one off basis.
